Doctor for 50 years, city golf champ dies

Dr. Robert R. Acre, 79, formerly of Evansville, died at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday at Hermitage Manor Nursing Home in Owensboro, Ky.

A native of Shoals, Ind., Dr. Acre was a urologist and practiced in Evansville for 50 years. He graduated from Indiana University School of Medicine in 1920.

An avid golfer, Dr. Acre was the first Courier City Tournament champion in 1930 and came back in 1931 to win the title again.

He was a member of the American Medical Association, the Indiana Medical Association, the American Urological Association, and the North Central Urological Section. He was past president of the Vanderburgh County Medical Association and served on the medical staffs of St. Mary's, Baptist and Deaconess hospitals here and at Community Methodist Hospital in Henderson.

He was a member of Reed Masonic Lodge, the Scottish Rite and the Hadi Shrine Temple.

Surviving are his wife, Beulah; a daughter, Mrs. Joan Robertson of Owensboro; a brother, Harry of Oklahoma City; three sisters, Mrs. Mable Hindman of Indianapolis and Misses Pauline and Ruby Acre, both of Corsicana, Tex; and two grandchildren.
