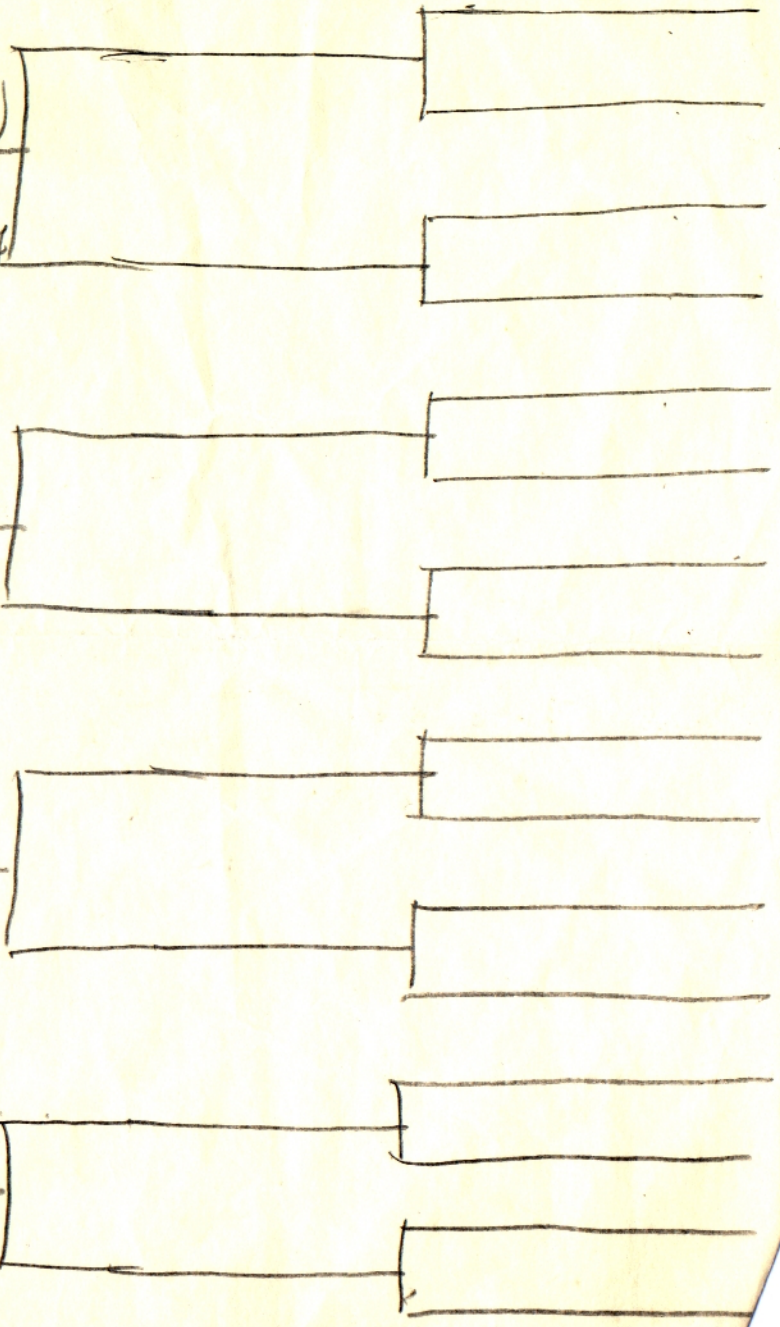

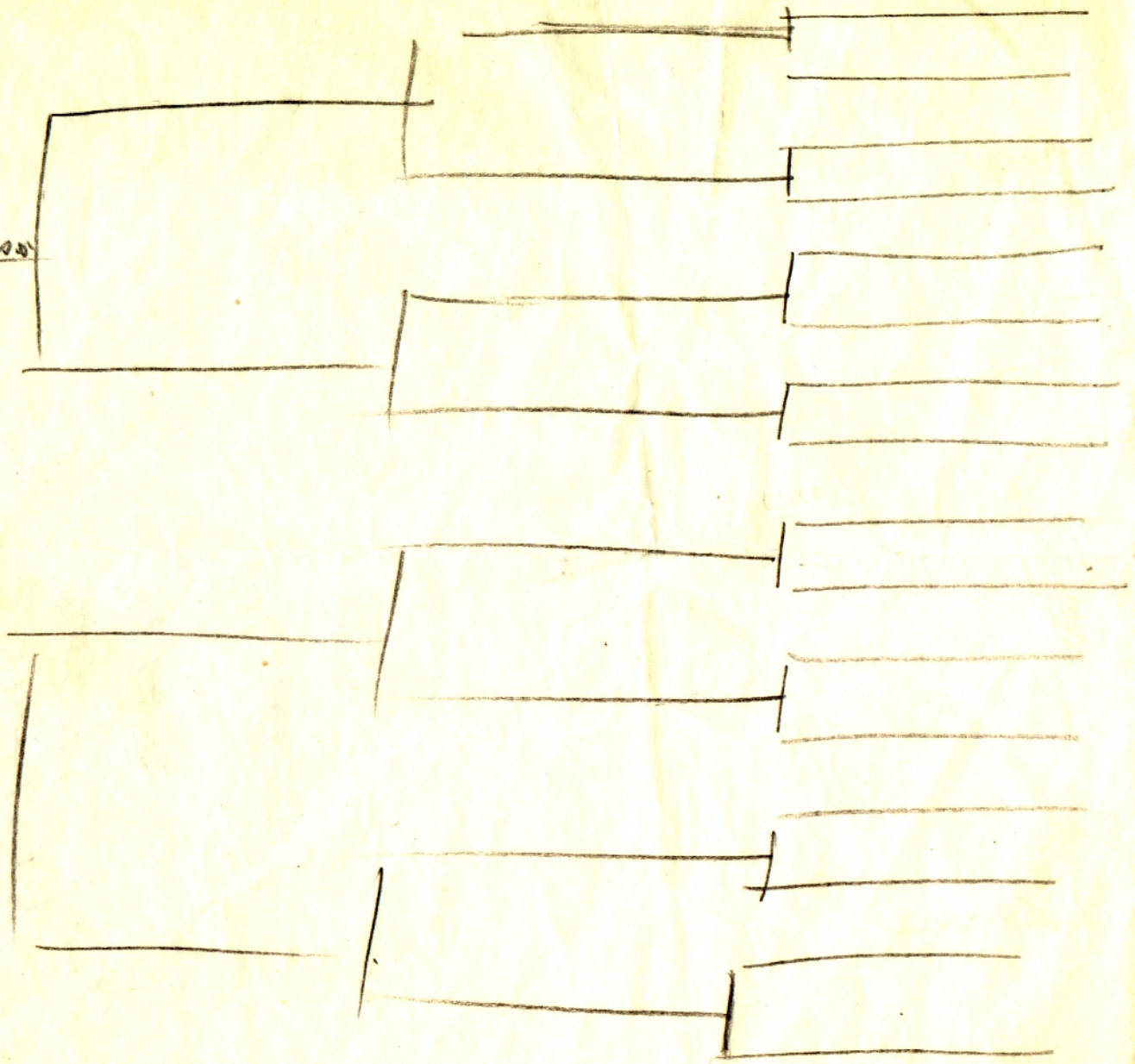

In June 1940 I deposited with your association the sum of Two Hundred Twenty (\$220.) Dollars to be applied on the purchase price of a certain lot or block in the new addition of the cemetery north of 38th Street Boulevard, conditionally on certain requirements set out in papers now in the possession of our son-in-law, Mr. T. M. Hindman, an officer in the State Board of Accounts.

Certain conditions prevent me from carrying out my intentions at this time.

At sometime, not far in the future, I want to establish a family burying lot in Crown Hill Cemetery. My deceased wife is now in a metallic casket here in Enid and I am not ready at this time to remove her to Crown Hill.

I would like if possible to cancel that contract and issue some kind of credit for the \$220. Paid so we could use that amount on another lot to be selected in Crown Hill later.

The Two Hundred Twenty (220.) Dollars was donated on the purchase of the lot we selected by two of my children to wit: Dr. Robert R. Acre of Evansville, Indiana who donated \$200, and Pauline Acre of Indianapolis, Indiana, \$20.

I am enclosing this letter with letter to the said T. M. Hindman who I hope can deliver same to you and make some satisfactory arrangements.
